ABOUT THE PROGRAM

The Masters Child Welfare Education Program (MCWEP) is a partnership among the New Jersey Department of Children and Families and a consortium of four New Jersey MSW programs—Monmouth University, Ramapo College, Rutgers University, and Stockton University - the lead institution. Its purpose is to offer current Department of Children and Families supervisors the opportunity to strengthen their skills in clinical social work practice and supervision, obtain an advanced credential in social work (MSW), and ultimately to enhance the capacity of DCF to deliver the highest quality services to the vulnerable children and families that it serves. **DCF will provide tuition and fees for applicants accepted into MCWEP.**

MCWEP Program Structure:

The program consists of three components:



ELIGIBILITY FOR THE PROGRAM

- DCP/Adoption Operations Casework Supervisors and Supervisors are eligible to apply for the program.
- Non-CPP Staff that are currently supervising.
- Non-CPP Supervisors with 3+ years of supervisory experience at DCF.
- Non-CPP Supervisors in a civil service title range 26 or higher.
- Applicants must have a bachelor's degree from an accredited institution.
- Applicants must agree to sign a legally binding agreement to continue their employment at DCF for one year for each year of support received.
- Applicants must meet admission requirements of the MSW program they choose to attend.



APPLICATION PROCESS

- Applicants must first apply through the DCF by completing the DCF "Application for Financial Support and Masters Child Welfare Traineeship"
- If selected by DCF, applicants then apply to the various MSW program(s).

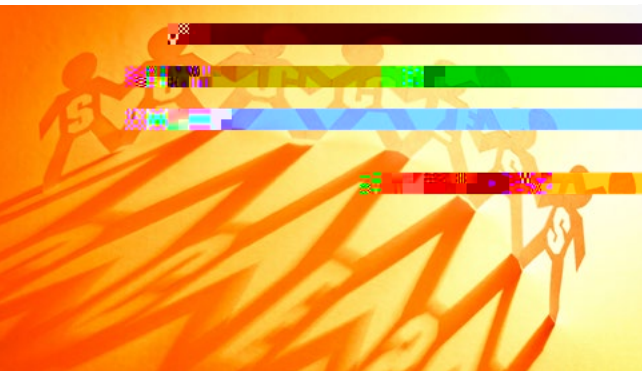
