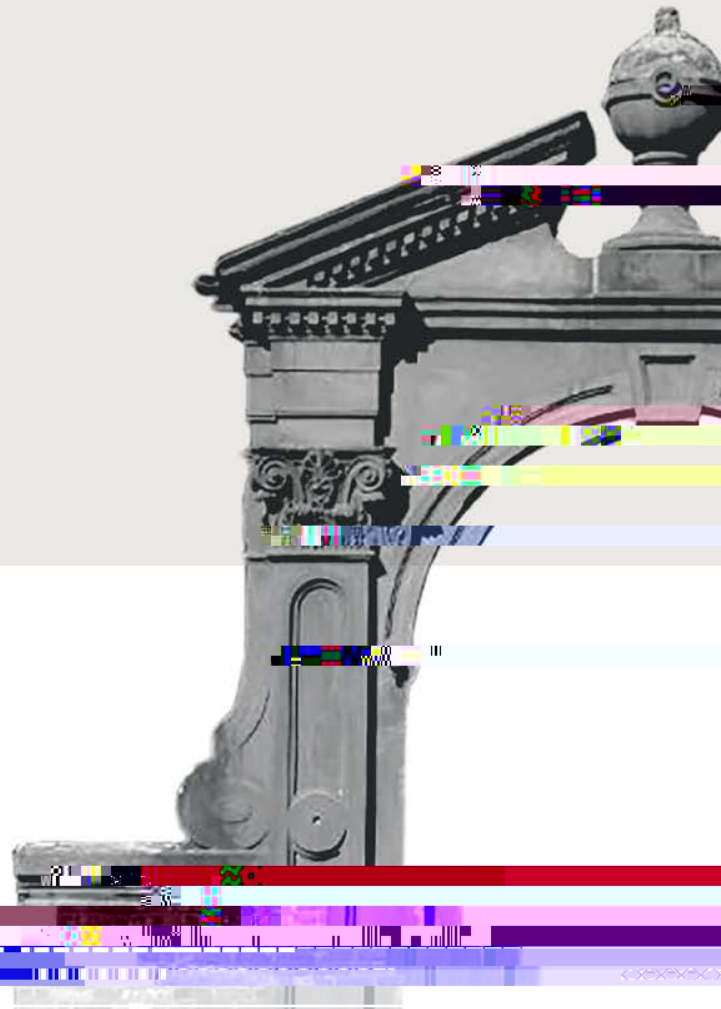

MSW Adv Standing students must choose Summer 2023 on the application which allows students to begin in Summer 2023 OR Fall 2023

'Application Deadlines:

Advanced Standing - **February 15, 2023**

FT & PT - **March 1, 2023**

Who qualifies for Advanced Standing?

Students who have earned a baccalaureate degree in social work (BSW) within the past five years from an undergraduate social work program accredited by the Council on Social Work Education may apply for the advanced standing track.

## Online Graduate Application

GPA - minimum 3.25 for Advanced Standing, 3.0 for FT/PT

Official College / University transcripts - waived for RCNJ students

BSW Fieldwork evaluation (Adv. Standing only)

2 survey recommendations

Survey recommendations cannot be submitted by the same individual who completed the fieldwork evaluation. The two survey recommendations and Fieldwork Evaluation must be submitted by three different individuals.
