Safety Measures for Laboratory or Research Activities



Notification of Parents or Legal Guardians in an Emergency

Procedure for Programs Involving Minors Operated by Outside Parties on Stockton University Property

Any program involving minors operated by outside organizations must be operated consistent with the requirements of the Protection of Minors Procedure.

All contracts for the use of University facilities by outside organizations must comply with the specified insurance requirements including sexual abuse and molestation coverage
