In July -Sept of 2022, a working group of faculty and staf responded to a compet tive bond proposal of ered through the Office of the Secretary of Education of New Jersey to carry out long delayed HVAC maintenance on E-Wing and renew the Richard E. Bjork Library at Stockton through the development of collaborative and technology forward learning spaces. Stockton successfully secured the 19.6-million-dollar bond for the E-Wing HVAC and library, along with an additional 1.7 million dollars for an innovative classroom project to update the technology in classrooms from A-D Wings. Fortunately, it appears that the monies from the State will arrive soon, and so both projects are now in the very beginning of the planning stages. The projects will span over the next two years in total, though construct on in the library will not begin unt I January 2025.
