(1 = not beneficial; 5 = extremely beneficial)








Despite having curriculum sheets and degree maps

The comparison question from this year to last doesn't allow me to say less streamlined did not prefer it and found as a program chair did more work to double check with was done in advance do not recommend this structure for complicated areas such as A where there is a wide variety of classes that could be taken
