Re: Intent to suspend admissions to the Bachelor of Science in Public Health program

In accordance with University Procedure 2040: The Life Cycle of Degree Programs, this memorandum conveys the unanimous faculty vote of the Bachelor of Science in Public Health program to suspend admissions to the program. At a meeting of the program on September 1, 2016 faculty voted to cease accepting applications for this program effective fall 2017.

The program has experienced declining numbers of enrolled students over the last several years. The faculty will study their options over this academic year and develop a plan to become incorporated into the Bachelor of Science in Health Science degree program. Dean Bartolotta has accepted the vote of the program faculty.

As per procedure, Dean Bartolotta will notify the Provost, Provost's Council and the Office of Admissions of this decision by the faculty of the Public Health program.
