Selection Criteria:

- Minimum 3.95 CUM GPA (summa cum laude), two spring 2014 ceremonies included
 3.95 GPA or higher from the 259 students with a 3.75 GPA or greater.
- Demonstrated campus impact through civic engagement, research and/or creativity
- Minimum RSC 64 credits earned and review of transfer GPA (if applicable) as posted
- Faculty nomination written in support of a student speaker candidate
- No social probation on record
