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Some of the results in South Jersey showed the most contrast. Cumberland was singled out as one of the most diverse counties, while being bordered by Cape May, Salem and Gloucester counties, among the least diverse.

"If you look at counties that have a good deal of diversity, their median age tends to be lower than the mostly white, non-diverse counties," Froonjian said. "You look at a county like Cape May that is strongly dominated by non-Hispanic whites, a lot of retirees, they're not having babies. But you look at Cumberland, Hudson, Essex, where you have a very diverse group of people, younger people,
