

## Richard Stockton College study shows Governor Christie holds lead over Barbara Buono

ATLANTIC COUNTY - According to a new study out of the Richard Stockton College of New Jersey, Republican Governor Chris Christie continues to holds a strong lead over Democratic challenger, State Senator Barbara Buono.

The Stockton Polling Institute says that 28 points separate the two.

The survey found that 58% of likely voters support the governor, while 30% are behind Senator Buono.

The institute, which is part of the William J. Hughes Center for Public Policy also found that Christie continues to enjoy a high approval rating with 68% holding a very favorable or somewhat favorable opinion of him.

Nearly half of the 812 likely voters surveyed say they are unfamiliar with Senator Buono.
