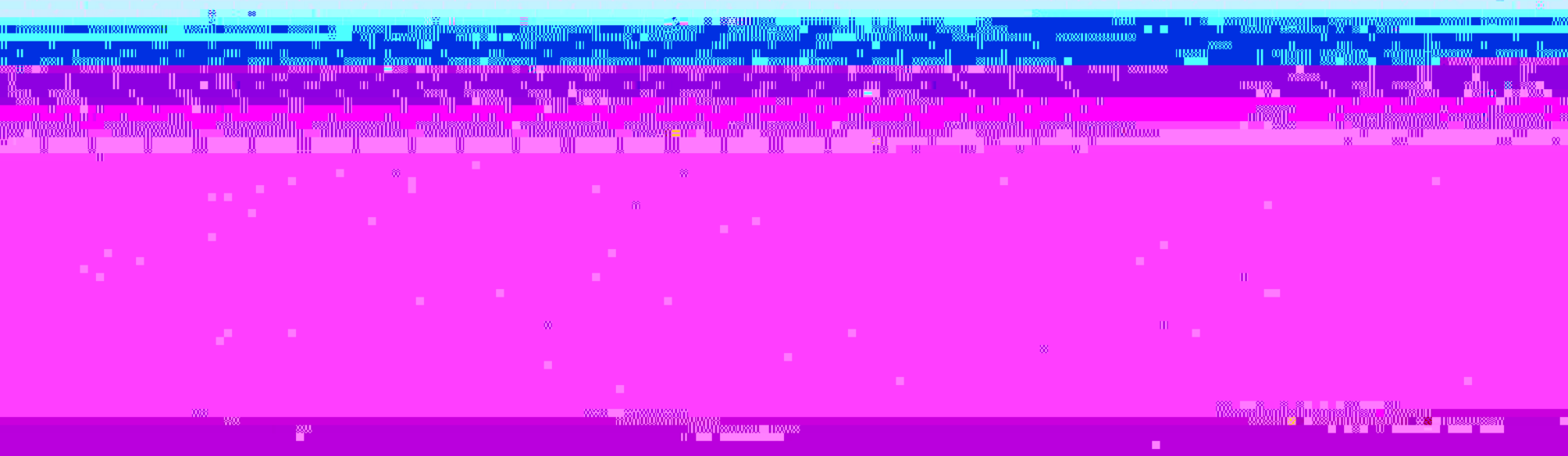

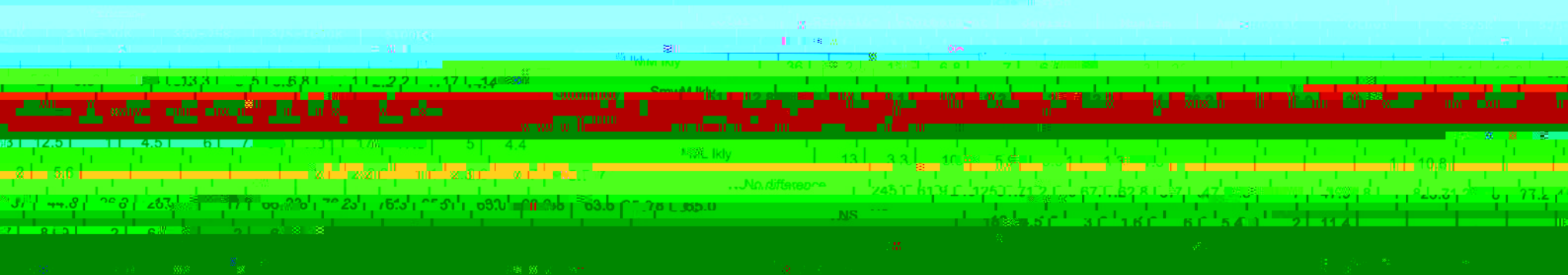


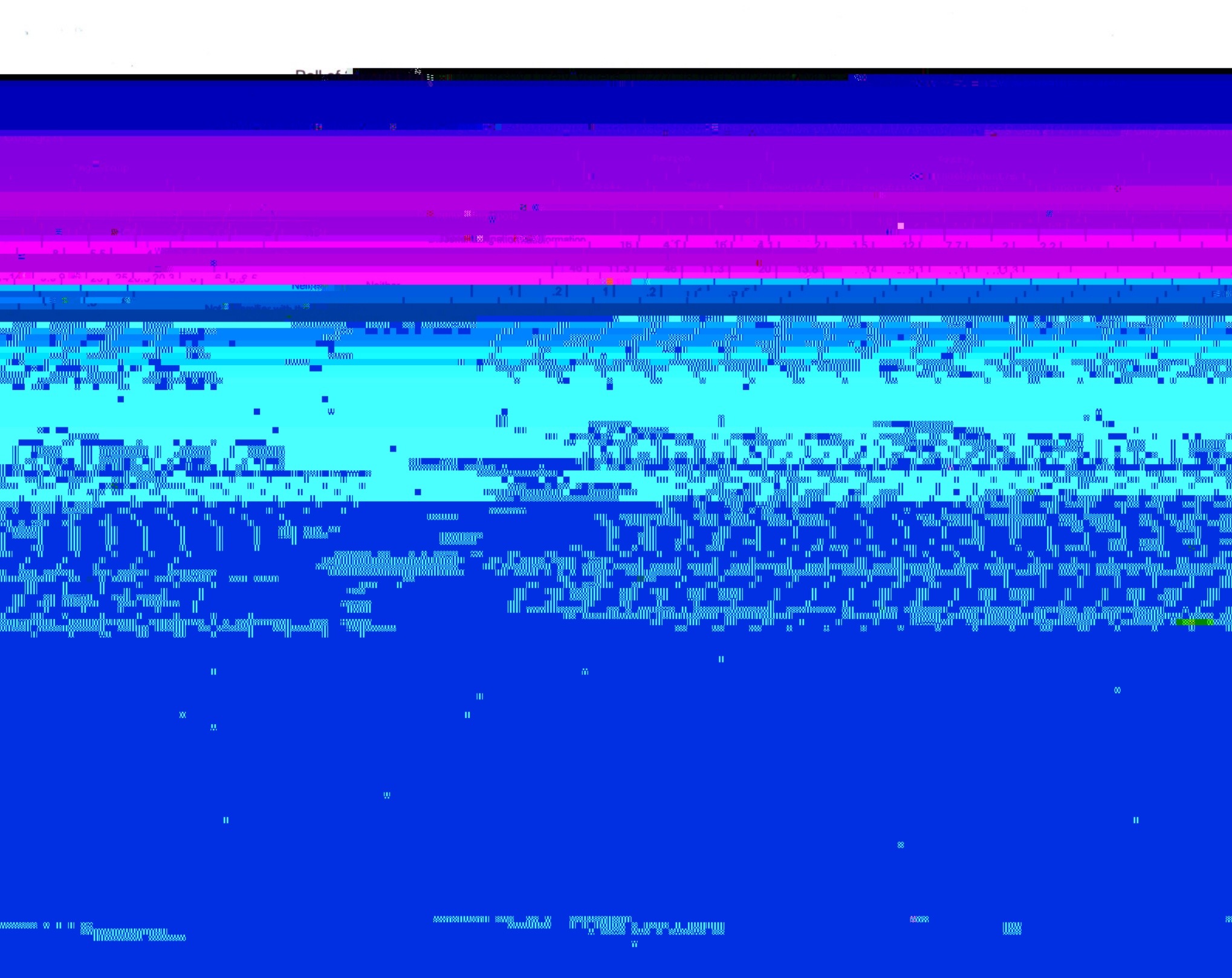
# Poll of 378 CA New Jersey Likely Voters 10/27/08 thru 11/11/08
