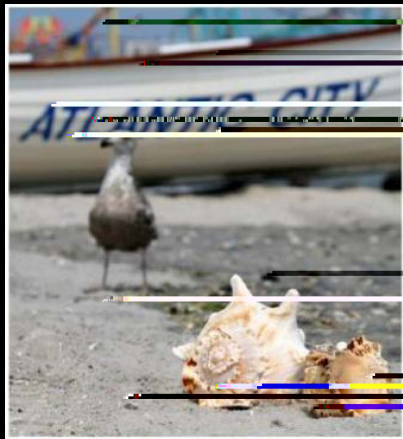

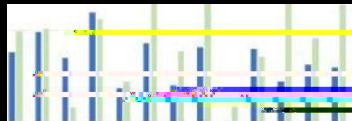

## ATLANTIC CITY'S ECONOMY

Building on the economic growth that Atlantic City has experienced over the past decade, the Atlantic City Economic Development Corporation (ACEC) has set a goal of adding 4,600 jobs by 2018, a 3.6 percent increase.
