

LIGHT Announces New Casino-Based Certificate on Resort Operations

The Integrated Casino Resort Operations Certificate was designed in collaboration with human resources professionals and industry experts to deliver the in-demand, industry specific skills they are looking for when promoting new talent, said Jane Bokunewicz, <u>LIGHT</u>

The eight-unit series covers the breadth of casino resort operations from gaming and surveillance to food and beverage to meetings and conventions and will give participants a background in all departments.

The program will run eight consecutive Tuesdays starting on Jan. 16, 2024 until March 4, 2024. Each three-hour, in-person workshop will be from 9 a.m. to noon and will take place at the Stockton Atlantic City campus.

The certificate was developed based on feedback from representatives of all nine Atlantic City casino hotels and will be taught by a team of 12 local experts.
