Venice suffers second-worst flood on record - As reported by **Travel Weekly**, the city of Venice, Italy experienced its worst flood in 50 years (74 inches) on Nov. 12. This was only 2.5 inches less than the record historic flood of 1966. The flooding, caused by heavy rains coinciding with high tide and a full moon
