### R&PD Main Room -

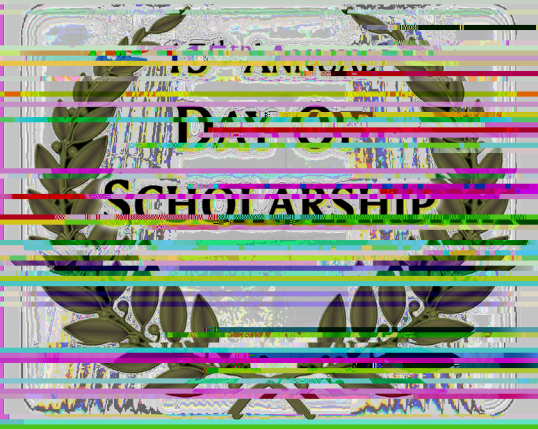
- Support for projects in research, planning, proposal writing, professional development, or grant preparation for seeking outside funding. Award for FY16.

Preservation Assistance Grants for Smaller Institutions are being offered by the National Endowment for the Humanities (NEH), Division of Preservation and Access.
