Principal Invest gators may have interest in a useful tool for tracking federal awards. <u>USASpending.gov</u> which is maintained by the Bureau of the Fiscal Service within the U.S. Department of the Treasury. The site was developed from provisions within the Digital Accountability and Transparency Act of 2014 and contains informat on on all federal appropriat ons and its recipients

The site allows for a search of exist ng federal grants and their recipients, which can potent ally ident fy possible partnerships. Searches can be made by agency or recipient, as well as other useful filters.

Agency prof les for every federal funder and detailed breakdowns of funding by state are also available, making this site a snapshot of the federal funding landscape for grant seekers.
