af er May 1 and on or before June 30.)

Amount: The prize carries a cash award of \$15,000 and publicat on by the University of Pit sburgh Press under its standard contract.

Abstract:

Eligible submissions include an unpublished manuscript of short stories; two or more novellas (a novella may comprise a maximum of 130 double-spaced typed pages); or a combinat on of one or more novellas and short stories. Novellas are only accepted as part of a larger collect on. Manuscripts may be no fewer than 150 and no more than 300 pages. Prior publicat on of your manuscript as a whole in any format (including electronic) makes it ineligible.

Translac 1 c an ancEligibility: The award is open to writers who of three short stories or novellas in magazines or journals of national distribution. Digital-only publication and self-publication do not count toward this requirement.

The award is open to writers in English, whether or not they are cit zens of the United States. University of Pit sburgh employees, former employees, current students, and those who have been students within the last three years are not eligible for the award.

Authors may submit more than one manuscript to the compet ton as long as one manuscript or a port on thereof does not duplicate material submit ed in another manuscript.

Grant applications will be considered only for major expenditures generally between \$50,000 and \$100,000 and great

- Grants for Libraries: Grant applications will be considered generally for resource Endowments (print, film, electronic database, speakers/workshops) capital construction and innovative equipment. Projects fostering broader public access to global information sources utilizing collaborative efforts, pioneering technologies and equipment are encouraged.
- Grants for Educat onal Institutions: Grant applications from universities, colleges and secondary schools will be considered generally for (a) educational endowments to fund scholarships based solely on educational achievements, leadership and academic ability of the student; (b) endowments to support fellowships and teaching chairs for educators who confine their activities primarily to classroom instruction in the liberal arts, mathematics and the sciences during the academic year; and (c) erection or endowment of buildings, wings or additions thereto of buildings, and equipment for educational purposes.
